

MX Web Part styling

For MX web part styling, the new file structure to access the web part stylesheets is:

/Resources/MX/Skins



Within this folder, there exists 5 files:


Bootstrap.css

Bootstrap.min.css

Mxcore-override.css

Mcore.css

mxcore.min.css





Bootstrap.css and Bootstrap.min.css are bootstrap related files which control the page structure. These are the same libraries that can be downloaded from https://getbootstrap.com/docs/4.1/getting-started/download/


Mxcore.css and mxcore.min.css along with bootstrap.css and bootstrap.min.css are the foundation style sheets for the mx web parts (mx finds, mx forms, create new user, registration, etc...) and MX UI. These should NOT be modified.

To modify the look and feel of MX web parts, please use the mxcore-override.css file. This file is where custom classes and any overwritten class styling should be placed.

Page Styling

For page styling, the new file structure for where your assets and stylesheets will be located is:

/Portals/0



Within this folder, you can place all your images, stylesheets, and any assets for the portal site.

To edit the site styling, please edit the Portal.css file. This file functions the same as themeoverrides.css did in previous versions of MX. Within here you can overwrite and place any custom styling done to the existing classes.




Within the /Portals/_default/Skins/MXOnline/assests/css exists the mxsite.css. THIS FILE SHOULD NOT BE EDITED. This is the foundation of the MXOnline Theme. Any edits to the theme should be made within the portal.css file.

Page Templates and Layout Files


For page layouts and template files, you can access them in the new file structure of:

/Portals/_default/Skins/MXOnline










If you wish to create new layout files for the page appearance or new page themes, you can place them directly in this folder.

For changes made to the layout of the actual page, you can find those web parts in:

/Portals/_default/Skins/MXOnline/layout-parts





Within here, you will find the default layout parts for the page structure such as the different footers, headers, navigation bar, etc... If you are planning on creating a custom template for the footer or another layout part, please place them in the custom folder.

IF YOU CREATE A CUSTOM LAYOUT PART:

You will have to include this segment code at the beginning of you .ascx template:

1 <!--#include file="../registers.ascx" -->

```

This segment of code will be used by the web.config file to load your custom template if it is placed in the custom folder.

When you create a custom folder and are loading it onto the file server, you will have to edit the web.config file located in the / directory of the file server to include.

For example:



```
| Company | Comp
```

In this example, I have created a custom footer called "myfooter.ascx". I want to load it to be the footer for site, so I will change the value of the footer key within the web.config file to reference the location of my custom footer and its name.

For instance, the default value was "value='footer-threecolumns.ascx", but it was changed to "value='custom/myfooter.ascx" to load the new, custom footer.

This same method will be used for using custom navigation, custom headers, and other custom layout parts that you will create.
